

Princeton, NJ - The 8th edition of the Jon M. Pritsch Cup took place on Friday, August 15, 2014 at the Gary Player designed TPC Jasna Polana. Ryder Cup style matches are played between twelve junior golfers from the Philadelphia Section PGA and twelve junior golfers from the New Jersey Section PGA. These twenty-four players earned their spot by placing themselves at the top of the Player of the Year points race in each section's Junior Tour. Once each player solidified their position with their respective section's roster, juniors played a singles and a four-ball match simultaneously, each worth 1 point, to gain the most points out of the 18 possible points to be earned.

Team New Jersey was fortunate enough to hoist the Pritsch Cup for the eighth year in a row. Since New Jersey came in as the defending champions, they only needed to earn 9 points on their afternoon to retain the Pritsch Cup. Early on, matches were back and forth between New Jersey and Philadelphia. Once all matches were completed, New Jersey won by the second largest margin of victory to date with a 9 point victory to finish with a total of 13 ½ points to Philadelphia's 4 ½.

The New Jersey Section PGA and the Philadelphia Section PGA alternate hosting the Jon M. Pritsch Cup year to year. In 2015, Philadelphia has hopes of getting on the board at a club in the Philadelphia Section PGA at a venue and date to be determined.

The Jon M. Pritsch Cup is played to honor the memory of Jon M. Pritsch who tragically passed away due to heart disease in May of 1991 at the age of 17. Before his passing, Pritsch was recognized as high as 8th in the country of junior golfers. It was Jon's dream to play professional golf, so Mr. and Mrs. Pritsch developed this fund to keep his dream alive. To date the Jon M. Pritsch Memorial Fund has given over \$140,000 in scholarships to juniors looking to pursue a career in a golf related field. Scholarship applications are sent out every year to all players in the Jon M. Pritsch Cup.
