

NEW JERSEY PGA TOURNAMENTS



All NJPGA Junior Tour Members are expected to read and understand the NJPGA Junior Tour's policy regarding COVID-19 Self-Screening and Self-Quarantining. The information below is intended to protect NJPGA Junior Tour Members, Families, Staff and Host Facilities.

Self-screening:

Players are expected to self-screen prior to attending any NJPGA event. The list of screening items are outlined below and players must withdraw from upcoming events if any of the following conditions apply.

- Diagnosed with COVID-19
- In close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19
- Advised to quarantine by a doctor or other medical authority
- Fever over 100.4° Fahrenheit
- Shortness of breath
- Abnormal coughing symptoms
- Loss of taste or smell, chills, shaking, sore throat or muscle aches
- Any other unusual flu-like symptoms

Face Coverings:

When it is not practicable for individuals in outdoor public spaces to socially distance and keep a six-foot distance from others all individuals shall wear face coverings.

If a player fails to comply, the NJPGA reserves the right to withdraw the entry of a player. Your cooperation and consideration are greatly appreciated.

Traveling From out of State:

Travelers and residents returning from any U.S. state or territory beyond the immediate region (New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Delaware) should self-quarantine at their home, hotel, or other temporary lodging following recommendations from the CDC:

- If travel is unavoidable, travelers should consider getting tested with a viral test (not an antibody test) 1-3 days before the trip and again 3-5 days after the trip.
- If travelers test positive, they should self-isolate for at least 10 days and should postpone travel during that time.
- If travelers test negative, they should quarantine for a full 7 days after travel.
- If testing is not available (or if the results are delayed), travelers should quarantine for 10 days after travel.

The advisory is no longer specific to certain states. Because of the high number of case counts across all states, there is an increased risk of spread of COVID-19 upon return from any travel.

Note: The New Jersey Department of Health is updating travel and quarantine guidelines to reflect [new recommendations from the CDC](#) and New Jersey is no longer advising fully vaccinated individuals who travel within the United States to self-quarantine after their trip or to get tested before or after travel. Please note that the [federal requirement](#) for testing upon return to the United States following international air travel stands - additional details are listed below.
