Who can apply for New Jersey Unemployment?

- *Worked only in New Jersey in the last 18 months, or*
- *Worked in New Jersey and any other state(s) in the last 18 months, or*
- *Worked for the federal government and in New Jersey in the last 18 months, or*
- *Served in the military in the last 18 months and be physically present in New Jersey.*

Can I apply for Unemployment in New Jersey if I previously worked in another state for the winter?

If you have qualifying wages in NJ you should be able to file in NJ even coming back from another state. If they are not residents, you may be able to file in NJ or in the previous state you last worked or reside in.

Has New Jersey extended unemployment benefits at this time?

No, at this time NJ has not extended unemployment. This may change at any time though.
